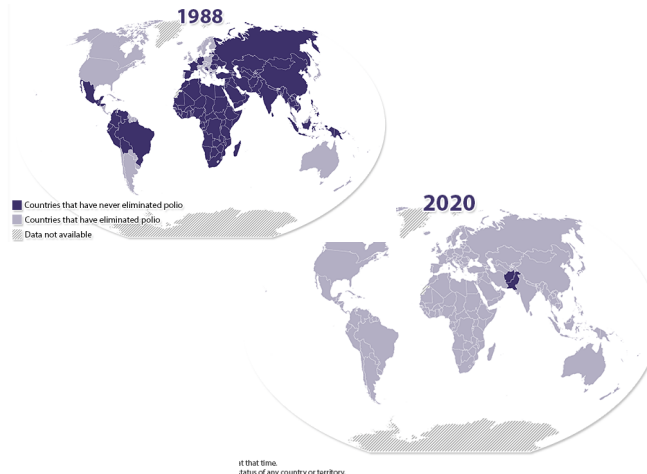


Rotary has been working to eradicate polio for more than 35 years. Our goal of ridding the world of this disease is closer than ever.

As a founding partner of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative, we've reduced polio cases by 99.9 percent since our first project to vaccinate children in the Philippines in 1979.

Rotary members have contributed more than \$2.1 billion and countless volunteer hours to protect nearly 3 billion children in 122 countries from this paralyzing disease. Rotary's advocacy efforts have played a role in decisions by governments to contribute more than \$10 billion to the effort.

Today, polio remains endemic only in Afghanistan and Pakistan. But it's crucial to continue working to keep other countries polio free. If all eradication efforts stopped today, within 10 years, polio could paralyze as many as 200,000 children each year.



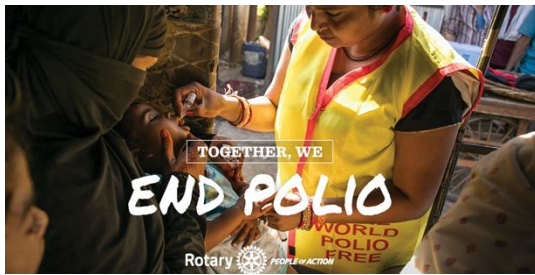

Effingham Noon and Sunrise Rotary Clubs work together in support of the Rotary International effort to eradicate polio worldwide. This event is held in honor of Noon Rotarian Dr. David Bristow, who was a strong advocate for the eradication of polio.

TOP FIVE REASONS TO ERADICATE POLIO:

1. To improve lives.

16 million people are walking today who would have otherwise been paralyzed.

2. To invest in the future.

If polio isn't eradicated, within 10 years, as many as 200,000 children could be paralyzed by it each year. A polio-free world will be a safer world for children everywhere.

3. To improve child health.

Polio surveillance networks and vaccination campaigns also monitor children for other health problems like vitamin deficiency and measles, so they can be addressed sooner.

4. To save money.

A polio-free world will save the global economy \$40-\$50 billion in health costs within the next 20 years.

5. To make history.

Polio eradication would be one of history's greatest public health achievements, with polio following smallpox to become only the second human disease eliminated in the world.

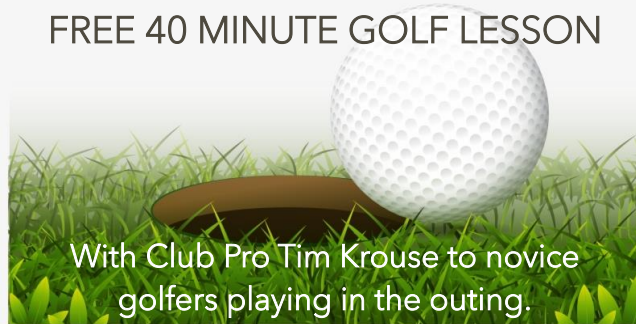
