

First National Bank of Dieterich

Even though The First National Bank of Dieterich has been around for over 100 years, the bank still finds ways to stay fresh in today's competitive and global economy. In the early years,



the bank served local farmers, merchants and citizens in the Village of Dieterich. Today there are 7 bank branches serving communities in

Effingham, Jasper, Randolph and St. Clair counties and a new Corporate Center located in Effingham opened early in 2013.

The main bank location still operates out of the location constructed in 1986 in Dieterich and branches have sprouted between Effingham and Teutopolis, near Lake Sara and in the heart of Newton in Jasper County. The bank's fifth location opened in downtown Effingham in 2008.

Since then, efforts have turned to acquisitions, with the acquisition of the First State Bank of Red Bud and its Belleville branch, completed in 2012. The loan processing center and corporate staff moved into the new Corporate Center along North Route 45 early in 2013.

Through its leadership, innovation, technology and genuine customer service, the bank's efforts have not gone unnoticed. SNL Financial named First National Bank of Dieterich #62 of the top 100 best performing community banks in the country with between \$500 million and \$5 billion in assets, the only community bank in Illinois to receive this honor. The Community Bankers Association of Illinois also recognized the bank as one of 13 Patrons of Community Banking, an honor it has received 11 times since 1991. CBAI also recognized the bank as the #1 participant in education programs – showing a strong commitment to their 100+ employees in providing them with quality education and training programs.

The First National Bank of Dieterich is an active participant in development of the communities they serve, participating in corporations like the Dieterich Community Development Corporation, the Effingham County Economic Development Foundation and Dieterich Business Association and in community service to organizations such as Rotary, Relay for Life, United Way and many others. They sponsored the inaugural Taste of Teutopolis fundraiser event to benefit Catholic Heart Work Camp to help pay for 76 students and 13 chaperones to participate in a mission trip. Bank employees also donate their time to help customers when they find there is a need.

Each fall, a large Customer Appreciation picnic draws hundreds of bank customers for a cookout and chance to win great prizes.




Versatech LLC was established in August 2008 in a 6,000 SF facility with 3 employees.

Rapid growth has led to two moves in the last 5 years, most recently to their current location at 1609 West Wernsing in the Effingham Business Park earlier this year. They currently employ 82 in their 75,000 SF Facility. More than 60% of Versatech's employees hold Engineering & Technical positions with another 20% filling Skilled Machinist roles.

Versatech's primary focus is in engineering, with nearly 65% of revenue generated from custom designed and built equipment and work holding solutions.

Versatech also offers a full service machine shop for build to print and low volume machining projects and prototype work. Three high-volume manufacturing lines to process automotive suspension components for Honda have been



added. As a full service supplier to its clients, Versatech also provides consulting services for projects including continuous improvement program implementation, equipment specification, plant layout, energy management solutions, & project management.

Versatech has been fortunate to partner with several customers and vendors and have been rewarded for their efforts in receiving additional business as well as receiving industry accolades.
